HOW T3 WORKS

With T3, you spend the equivalent of 3.5 days at school completing Year 12 subjects and a half day per week at TAFE in a Certificate II course.

On the remaining weekday you work in paid employment at a Toyota Dealership.

On completing your Year 12 Certificate and your TAFE Certificate II, you can choose to take up full-time employment with your Toyota Dealership in your choice of three career streams.

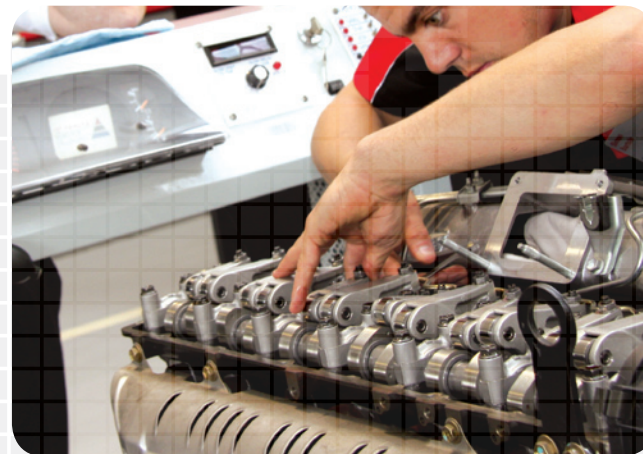
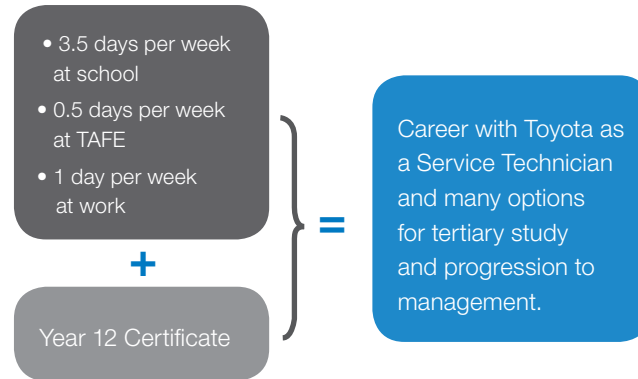
Accelerate your career – Apply for T3 in Year 10 and choose from three great career choices in a high-tech industry.

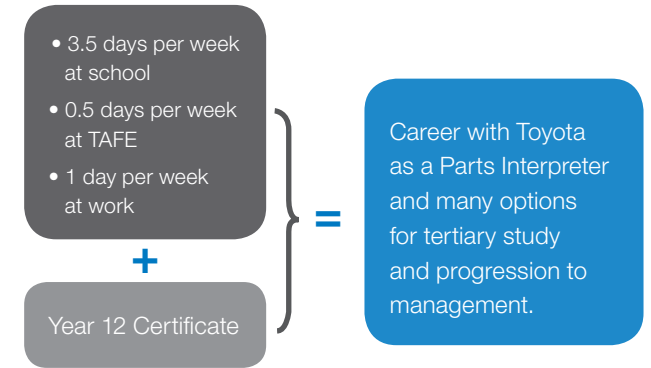


Parts Interpreting
